

Using the resource finder

1. Open the 'Resource finder' tab at the top-right of the page
2. Select the 'Start quiz' button



3. Answer the questions by selecting the appropriate icons
4. Some questions allow you to select multiple options, or none
To undo the selection, click on the icon a second time
5. Select 'Next' to move to the next page
You can restart the quiz at any time by using the button at the top-right of the page

Filtering the resources


1. Navigate to the 'Resources' tab at the top of the page
2. Open the filter topics (goals, location, language, custodian) and select the options you are interested in
The numbers show how many results there are for each option
3. Apply the filter/s
You can add filters or reset the search at any time

4. Select the squares to learn more about each resource.



2. Select 'view all results' or the blue search icon to view the matching results




3. Scroll down to see more results
