

How to translate a website




If you are relying on translated material for official purposes, we recommend having the translation checked by a fluent speaker.

To translate an entire website, open translate.google.com

This is a free resource, you do not need an account to access it

1. Select 'Websites' at the top of the screen
2. Copy the URL of the website you would like to translate and paste it in the text box
3. Use the drop-down menu on the right side to select the language you would like the website translated to
4. Click on the blue arrow on the right side.




Now you can navigate the website in your chosen language

1. You can change the language from the drop-down menu at the top-left of the page
2. You can toggle between the original language and the translated version using the drop-down at the top-right of the page.

Some dashboards can't be accessed using the Google Translate URL



In this case, open the website using Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge

1. Right-click and select 'Translate to...' to choose your preferred language

You might need to close and re-open the items on the page to refresh the text. Each page must be individually translated.



2. Change the language using the drop-down menu or choose to show the original text.


